Dissemination Seminar Regarding PDHS survey, Sindh Medical College, Karachi

On 30th June 2009 Pakistan National Forum on Women's Health in collaboration with TACMIL Health Project, organized a seminar regarding dissemination of information from PDHS survey at Sindh Medical College Karachi

More than 200 participants including medical students, midwives, nurses, and doctors from different faculties of this college attend the seminar.

Different faculty members gave presentations on the key findings of PDHS. They informed the audience about condition of maternal and child health, fertility rate and child and infant mortality rate in Pakistan. All the topics were presented in detail, statistics and reasons behind the findings were also shared with the audience.

In the end faculty members encouraged all their medical team including students, doctors, nurses and midwives to work together to achieve Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) 4 and 5 i-e "Reduce Child Mortality" and "Improve Maternal Health".

All the key speakers agreed that sharing of PDHS findings is a very useful activity as it gives additional knowledge to their staff and students and they can play their individual roles in achieving MDGs by 2012.
