



Capacity Building: Training of Master Trainers for “Establishing CMWs in the Community”

An MTOT was conducted in Islamabad with 24 participants during July in order to identify a cadre of people to conduct the training course to 900 CMWs. The specific objective of the MTOT was to enable the trainers to understand and apply the concepts, skills and information in the training program ‘Establishing CMW’s in the Community’. The trainers were taught to use experiential and participatory methods for effective delivery of the training course.

During the MTOT, the course ‘Establishing CMWs in the Community’ was conducted in its entirety, both to train participants in the content and technical material of the course and to identify content and material that required revision.

The major point emphasized with the trainers is the need to follow the notes and sequence provided in the trainers guide. The trainers guide is a detailed document that describes the sequence of content, provides developed activities and exercises for the trainers to use.
